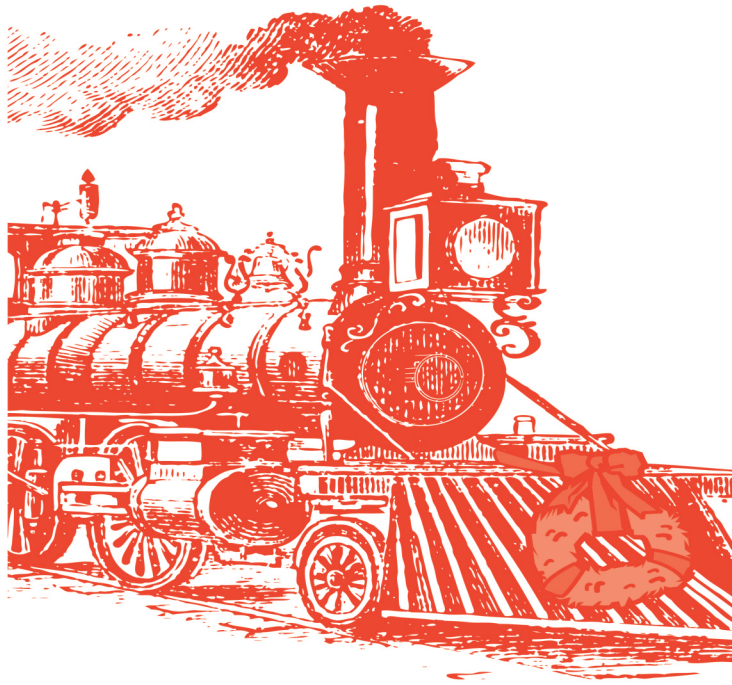

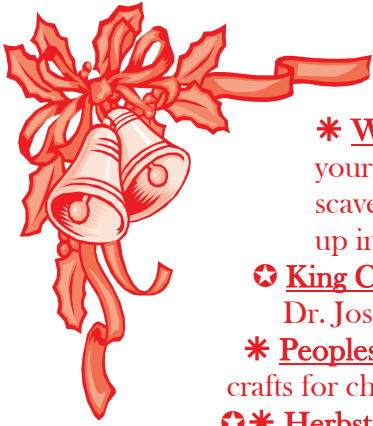


To enter, follow these simple steps:

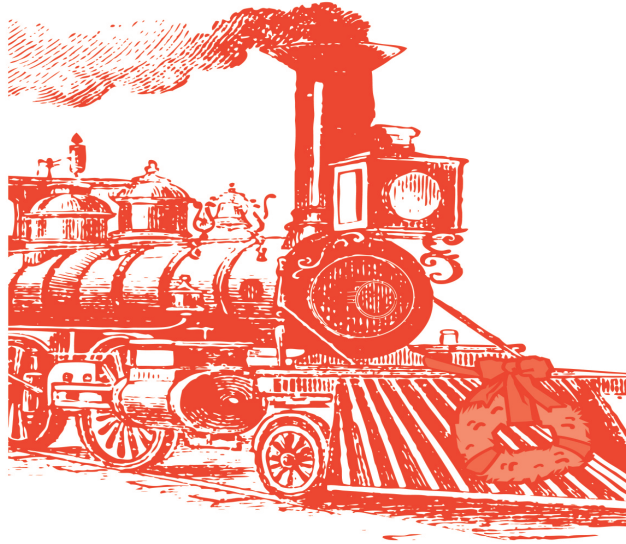
