RESOLUTION: 891-21 A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSBURG STATING THE NECESSITY TO PROCEED FOR THE CURRENT ELECTION OF A RENEWAL TAX LEVY FOR CURRENT OPERATING EXPENSES

Council for the Village of Williamsburg, Ohio met in regular session this 8th day of April, 2021 with the following members present:

Councilman Anthony Pearcy for the adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY FOR LEVYING TAX EXCEEDING TEN-MILL LIMITATION

Whereas, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Williamsburg, Clermont County, Ohio: and

Whereas, a resolution declaring the necessity of levying a tax under RC 5705.19(A) outside the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of current operating expenses must be passed and certified to the county auditor of Clermont County in order to permit Council for the Village of Williamsburg, Ohio to consider the levy of such tax and must request that the county auditor certify to Council for the Village of Williamsburg, Ohio the total current tax valuation of the Village of Williamsburg, Ohio and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the number of mills required to generate a specified amount of revenue;

NOW THEREFORE BE IS RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Williamsburg, State of Ohio at least 3/4 of the members concurring:

- 1. That it is necessary to levy a renewal of an existing five (5.0) mill operating levy for the purpose of generating funds to pay the current expenses of the Village of Williamsburg, Ohio; which rate is the same as the rate currently in place as provided in Revised Code Section 5705.19(A) at a rate not exceeding five (5.0) mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifty cents (\$0.50) for each hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation for a period of five (5) years beginning with tax year 2022 and ending with 2026.
- That the levy be placed upon the tax lists, commencing in 2022 first due in calendar year 2023, in compliance with Ohio Revised Code section 5705.34, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.
- 3. That the question of such tax levy be submitted to the electors of the Village of Williamsburg, Clermont County, Ohio at the election to be held therein on November 2, 2021.
- 4. That the Clerk is hereby directed to certify a copy of the resolution to the county auditor and the board of elections, Clermont County, Ohio. Council for the Village of Williamsburg, Ohio hereby requests that the county auditor certify to this Council the total current tax valuation of the Village of Williamsburg, Ohio and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by five (5.0) mills if approved by the electors.
- 5. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
