ORDINANCE: 1202-22

AN ORDINANCE BY THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSBURG AUTHORIZING THE RENAMING OF OLD STATE ROUTE 133 TO CAMBRIA DRIVE

WHEREAS Ohio Revised Code Section 723.04 provides that the legislative authority of a municipal corporation, on petition by a person owning a lot in the municipal corporation praying that a street or alley in the immediate vicinity of such lot, the name thereof be changed, upon hearing, and upon being satisfied that there is good cause for such change of name, vacation, or narrowing, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and that it should be made, may, by ordinance, declare such street or alley the name thereof be changed. The original ordinance or a certified copy thereof shall be recorded in the official records of the county; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Williamsburg has received a petition to change the name of Old State Route 133 to Cambria Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Williamsburg has determined that there is good cause for such change of name, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and that it should be made; and,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Williamsburg, Clermont County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. There is good cause to change the name of Old State Route 133 to Cambria Drive exists and such a change of name will not be detrimental to the general interest;

Section 2: That the Administrator be and hereby is authorized to take all steps necessary to effectuate the change of name of Old State Route 133 to Cambria Drive, including presentment for recordation of a certified copy of this ordinance with the official records of the county.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
