

## AN ORDINANCE BY THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSBURG

## ORDINANCE: 1213-23 AN ORDINANCE BY THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSBURG TO VACATE RIGHT OF WAY FOR EXTENSION OF 5<sup>TH</sup> STREET, 6<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND WALNUT STREET.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 723.05 authorizes a municipal corporation the authority to vacate a street or alley where there is good cause and such vacation is not detrimental to the general interest; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it holds the right of way for an extension of 5<sup>th</sup> Street from Gay Street to Walnut Street, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it holds the right of way for an extension of 6<sup>th</sup> Street from Gay Street to Walnut Street; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it holds the right of way for an extension of Walnut Street from 5th Street; and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed the rights of way and has determined that there is good cause for vacating each right of way, and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Williamsburg, Clermont County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the right of way for an extension of the road way from 5<sup>th</sup> Street from Gay Street to Walnut Street, is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. That the right of way for an extension of the road way from 6<sup>th</sup> Street from Gay Street to Walnut Street, is hereby vacated.

SECTION 3. That the right of way for an extension of the road way from Walnut Street from 5th Street to 6th Street, is hereby vacated.

**SECTION 4.** The Village Administrator and Village Solicitor are directed to take all steps as would be necessary to vacate the right of way.

SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitation, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
